

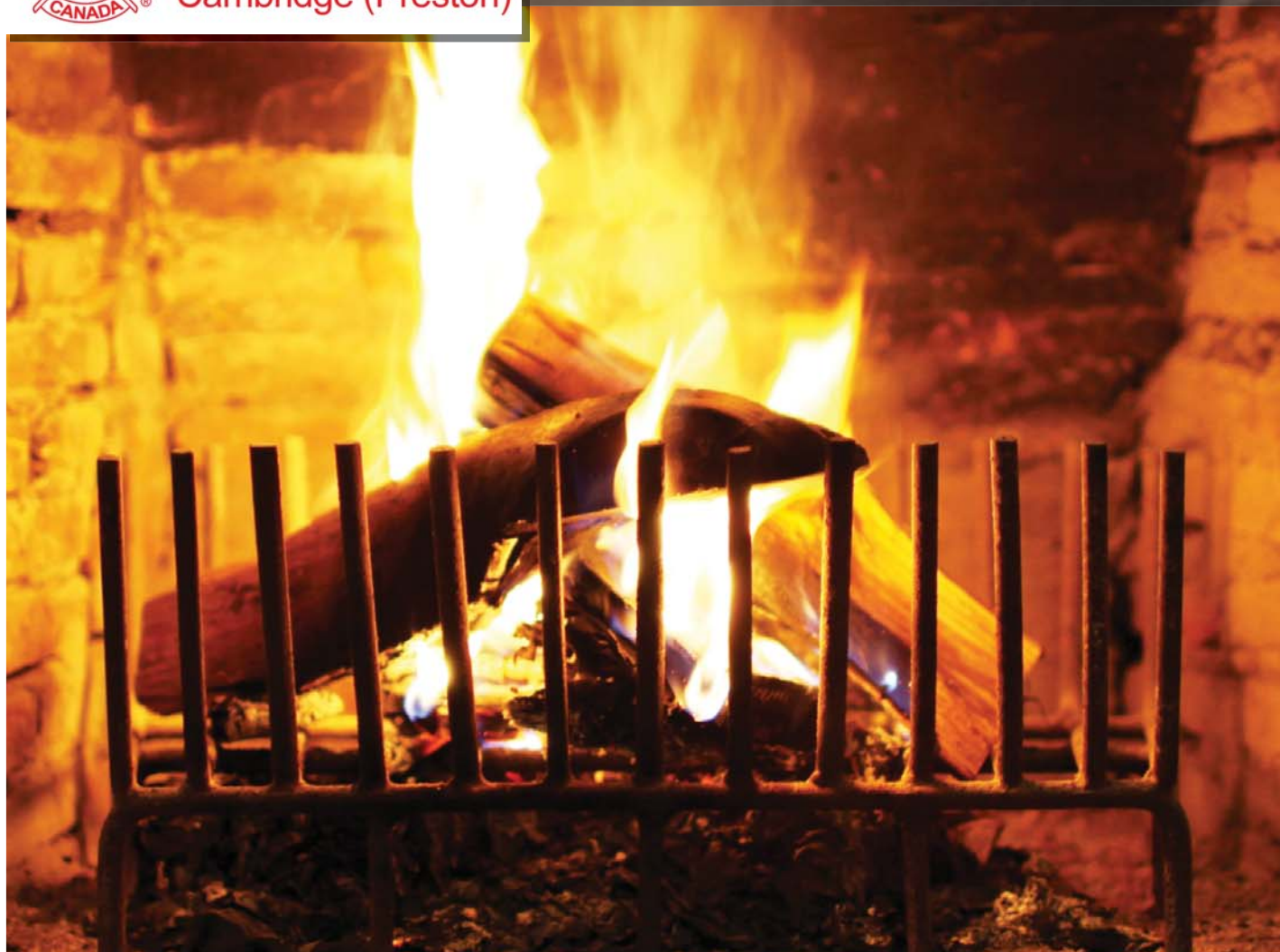

9. **Guest Speaker** – Keith Rivers from House of Friendship – Close to Home. Motion by LM Jerry to donate \$1,000 from Kin Bingo, seconded by Deedee. Carried.
10. **Address to the Chair** – President Chris, guests & Fellow Kin – IT’s the most wonderful time of the year!
11. **Treasurers Report** – Motion by LM Jerry to accept his report as printed in the bulletin, seconded by LM Earl. Carried.
12. **Secretary’s Report** – Motion by Melissa to accept the Executive and General minutes as printed in the bulletin, seconded by Ron Earl. Carried with abstension by Deedee.
13. **Registrar** – 15/25, 64% tonight with makeups. YTD 62.5%
14. **Membership Report** – Contract from National regarding a person who is interested in either joining or helping with our clubs. Chris has contacted her, and she hopes to be able to attend the Christmas party or January’s General meeting.
15. **Bulletin Editors Report** – Dan is looking for bios from the members of the Executive who have not submitted one yet.
16. **CF / Service Report** –
 - a. Snow Golf will be held on January 20th, at Grand Valley at 11 pm. Meal to be served at the hall following the golfing. LM Wendy is looking for donations for the prize table. LM Wendy has also requested contact information from Deedee, from past years.
 - b. National Day of Kindness – February 24th.
 - c. CF Night – Not sure of date at this point, but this will happen at some point
17. **Bingo** – There is one more bingo left this year – December 20th. Sylvia is working it, but Wendy is not able to work that evening due to an injury. Melissa will work it.
18. **Project Reports** –
 - a. Wish Tree – We came in well under budget, yet managed to buy for 200 kids plus toiletries. Good attendance. Great Job Nancy!
 - b. Breakfast with Santa – Ended up being Cancelled.
 - c. Storage Clean-up – LM Wendy is having trouble getting a hold of the Galt Little Theatre, and the Drama teacher from Preston High School has not returned Wendy’s calls.
 - d. Golf Tournament – September 8th at Grand Valley Golf Tournament. Our cost is \$60 per person, including the meal. Will likely charge \$100 per person. Golfers will be required to pre-pay. We have already put down a \$200 deposit to hold the date at the Golf Course. We should be doing some advertising through the Cambridge Chamber.
19. **Old Business** –

- a. Thank you letter from Glenview Secondary School. They have invited some of the club members to join then that day – December 20th. Passed to Dan for the bulletin. If anyone is interested in going, please let Deedee know.

20. Hall Report –

- a. Thanks to Eric, the hall now has a working furnace
- b. Michelle has resigned as Hall Chair due to personal issues, so the position will be up for tender immediately. Chris will step up to be acting Hall Chair until the position can be filled. Chris will need assistance with some of the cleaning that goes along with maintaining and running the hall.
- c. Tender Submissions – Requested remuneration, whether you want to do bookings and/or cleaning, if you will be doing it alone or with a co-chair. Due prior to the January executive meeting.
- d. Rental Rates – We are finding that there are halls in the area that are cheaper than what we are asking. The executive is suggesting:
 - i. Bartender - \$100
 - ii. Weekend, Alcohol Event - \$300
 - iii. Weekend, Non-alcohol Event \$200
 - iv. Daytime, Non- alcoholic Event - \$100
 - v. Member Rate - \$100
 - vi. Motion to accept the rates as presented by Ron, seconded by Maggie. Carried.

21. Spring Convention – We have the opportunity to put on up to 6 Rock Kin Roll acts at convention – likely Friday night. Motion to go into a Committee of the Whole by LM Wendy, seconded by Adrian. Motion to come out the Committee of the Whole by Adrian, seconded by Nancy. Motion by LM Melissa to consider preparing up to 6 Rock Kin Roll acts for Spring Convention, seconded by Deedee. Carried. LM Wendy and Deedee have volunteered to co-chair the event.

22. POH Event – Montreal Canadiens Alumni hockey game, playing against first responders – March 3rd – at Waterloo Rec Centre. Tickets are \$75 per person, which includes a meet and greet and lunch, or \$25 for general admission. There will be a 50/50 draw, silent auction, portrait copy will be on display.

- a. Christmas Party is this Saturday at 7:00 pm. Cost is \$5 per person, and you can participate in a \$10 gift exchange.

1. **Call to Order** – 6:55 pm
2. **Attendance** – Chris, LM Jerry, LM Wendy, Dean, Nancy, Adrian, LM Melissa
3. **Treasurers Report** –
 - a. Accounts – Motion to accept report as circulated by LM Jerry, seconded by Adrian. Carried.
 - i. Kinette Bingo
 - b. Bell Cartage – Bill was supposed to be given to the Music Fest committee, but was not. Bill was dated June 23, 2017. The agreement was that the Music Fest would pay the majority of the bill – it was just to be in our name. We are on the hook for the charge for delivery of the stage in the amount of \$654.95, as the bill was not submitted to the festival in time. Recommendation to General that the club pay the bill out of service, regret, by LM Jerry. Seconded by Nancy. Carried. Recommendation to General by LM Wendy that we do not take on this project next year. Seconded by Adrian. Carried.
4. **Secretary's Report** –
 - a. Christmas card and Newsletter from Bryan May – Posted on bulletin board
 - b. ULINE Catalogue – Passed on to Chris
5. **Bulletin Editors Report** – Dan not present
6. **CF/Service Report** – Snow Golf is January 20th at Grand Valley Golf & Country Club, with the meal to follow at the Kin Hall. Wendy to send Melissa the details, so that the event can be set up on Facebook and Kijiji.
7. **Membership Report** – Eric not present. Contact forwarded to club from National HQ – Chris is trying to get her out to the next meeting.
8. **Hall Report** –
 - a. Motion to go into Community of the Whole to discuss the future of the Hall Chair position by Nancy, seconded by Dean. Carried. Motion to come out of the Committee of the Whole by LM Wendy, seconded by Dean. Carried.
 - b. Tender – As of last Saturday, Michelle has resigned from both her position as hall chair and Co-club Registrar. Motion to accept with regret made by LM Jerry, seconded by Adrian. Carried.
 - c. Keys – Chris is only able to locate on set of renters keys. Michelle indicated that they were supposed to be in the locked cupboard in the bar – that is not the case. In addition, Tiffany has the full set of hall chair keys as well as the Carnival keys (and locks) – and she is refusing to return them because it “satisfies her need for control”. If none of the mentioned keys can be located and/or returned to the club, we will need to have all of the locks re-keyed. Kin Paul Durdin will work out a deal with the club if we do need to re-key the locks. Executive present at the meeting was in agreement with Chris taking steps to get the keys from Tiffany.
 - d. Furnace – The blower motor has been repaired thanks to Good Kin Eric. The total cost of this repair will be around \$750. Motion recommend to General by LM Jerry to pay

the bill as soon as received, from Service. Seconded by Nancy. Carried. Request by Chris that the club looks into getting quotes for a furnace maintenance plan.
