12. **Registrar’s Report** – 54.5% attendance
13. **Membership Report** – Eric not present. Tom Kelly, Steve Cherry and Stephanie Belsher have been removed from the roster.
14. **Bulletin Report** – Awesome bulletin as always. Congratulations to Dan for winning the Zone Sr. Bulletin Award.
15. **Cystic Fibrosis / Service Report** –
 - a. CF Night – April 20th. Catered by Grand Valley Catering. Meal cost is \$25. Dean has asked Alice Awwenh from CFC to try and find us a guest speaker.
 - b. Golf Tournament – September 8th, at Grand Valley Country Club.

April 29, 2018

1. **Call to Order** – 7:02 pm
2. **Attendance** – Chris, LM Wendy, LM Jerry, Dan, Maggie, Dean, LM Melissa
3. **Treasurer's Report** –
 - a. Carnival cheques were ordered last year, but have been misplaced. Replacement cheques will need to be ordered ASAP.
 - b. Account report will be included in the bulletin
 - c. LM Jerry is meeting a representative from the Cambridge Foundation at the hall tomorrow at 2 pm, to discuss the grant application. The maximum grant is \$2,500, which would leave an approximate cost of \$1,900 (based on the current estimate)
4. **Secretary's Report** – Bank statements for all accounts and utility bills have been passed to LM Jerry. No other mail.
5. **Membership Report** –
 - a. Eric would like to investigate award options for the club....whether they be official Kin Awards or ones created by Eric. Suggested that he look into the Maple Leaf and Founders Awards criteria for the club members.
 - b. Suggestion that we look into nominating a person to be in charge of marketing the club through Social Media platforms....events, membership.
6. **Bulletin Report** – Since winning the award, Dan's ego has been greatly inflated. Upcoming bulletin will be great!
7. **CF / Service Report** –
 - a. Great speakers from CF Night – We had 2 parents who are at different stages in their children's CF Journey – Paige with a toddler, and Bea Crowley with a son who is a couple of years post transplant.
 - b. Golf Tournament is on September 8th.
8. **Hall Report** –
 - a. Hall is renting really well, lately. Sylvia is doing a great job.
 - b. Not certain if the air conditioner is working....Chris will come in on Wednesday to test it. If it is not working, we should consider approaching Watson Mechanical for servicing. They were very helpful, when it came to repairing the blower motor.
 - c. There is a hole in the wall in the men's washroom that needs to be repaired.
 - d. Floor in the entrance to the kitchen needs to be repaired, after it was damaged by a renter.
9. **Projects**
 - a. BBQ's – We have not heard anything from the Vasculitis Foundation.
 - b. Carnival – Things are progressing.
 - i. Chris has an email prepared to go out to all the dance places in the next week or two. He will also be contacting some of the local Cheer organizations, to see if they are interested. Also looking for high school bands that may want to play for free to market themselves.

- ii. Zehrs is not on board for selling presale tickets for us, due to reduced staffing levels as a result of the increase in the minimum wage. Giant Tiger, No Frills and Cambridge Surplus is on board. May 13th, we are booked in at the Cambridge Centre in the Community Service Booth, from 11 am to 5 pm.
- iii. Chris is having a site meeting with the new Parks & Rec person with the city.
- iv. Dan is working on updating the Carnival portion of the club website.
- c. Upstairs Clean-up – Assumption is that we will not be doing any Rock Kin Roll acts at Spring Convention, so we should work on getting rid of all the costumes, props, instruments, etc. We will need to bring in a bin to get rid of the items.
- d. DLS – Nancy will be doing the meals for the District Leadership Seminar in May.

- a. Trailer – Frank Jordan from Hunts Transport may be willing to move and store the trailer for the club. Franklin Storage may also be willing to let us store the trailer at their location.
